DAY 1: USA / ROME

(Sunday, Nov. 3rd) Your pilgrimage begins today as you depart on your flight to Rome.

DAY 2: ROME / ORVIETO / ASSISI

(Monday, Nov. 4th) Upon arrival in Rome, we will board our touring vehicle, exit the airport, and stop at the Fiumicino Fuel Stop for a hot chocolate and croissant. We will then travel through the Umbrian hills to Orvieto. We will visit the Orvieto Cathedral, where the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena is kept. After celebrating Mass, our group will enjoy a welcome lunch at a local restaurant, including the famous regional Orvieto Classico wine. Afterward, we will travel to Assisi for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 3: ASSISI: ST. FRANCIS BASILICA / CHURCH OF ST. CLARE

(Tuesday, Nov. 5th) After breakfast, we will visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica and the Porziuncola (the tiny church within the church with a famous indulgence). Next, we will continue to the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, where his body is entombed. After Mass, we will walk through this quaint little town. After lunch (on your own), you'll have some leisure time. Afterward, we will visit the Basilica of St. Clare and the Chapel of San Damiano, where St. Francis received his call to rebuild the Church. Today's last stop will be the Sanctuary of the Spoliation, where we will see the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis in the Church of St. Mary Major. Dinner will be at a local restaurant tonight, with wine tasting overlooking the Umbrian hillside. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Assisi.

DAY 4 FLORENCE / ASSISI

(Wednesday, Nov. 6th) Following breakfast, we will travel to Florence. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at the Santa Croce Church, followed by a city tour. We will see Michelangelo's statue of David at the Academy of Fine Arts, followed by the Gothic-style Ponte Vecchio Duomo and the Baptistery, with its celebrated bronze doors. After lunch (on your own), you'll have time to explore more of Florence before returning to Assisi for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 5: ASSISI / ROME

(Thursday, Nov. 7th) After breakfast, we will check out of the hotel and drive to the beautiful, picturesque city of Rome! Upon arrival, we will visit and celebrate Mass at the church of St. Paul Outside the Walls. After lunch at a local restaurant, we will enjoy a city tour, exploring more famous Roman sites such as the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Castel Sant'Angelo. Tonight's dinner will be at a local restaurant. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 6: ROME: ST. PETER'S BASILICA / VATICAN MUSEUM

(Friday, Nov. 8th) After breakfast, we will visit St. Peter's Basilica, where St. Peter, the first Pope and Bishop of Rome, was martyred. We will view Michelangelo's Pieta and the tomb of Saint John Paul II in St. Sebastian's

Chapel. Next, we will explore the underground grottoes and visit the tomb of Pope Benedict XVI. We will then celebrate Mass, followed by lunch at a local restaurant. This afternoon, we will tour the Vatican Museum, including the Raphael Rooms and Sistine Chapel, and see Michelangelo's Masterpiece, the restored mural of the Last Judgment. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 7: ROME: WALKING TOUR OF FOUNTAINS AND **SQUARES**

(Saturday, Nov. 9th) After breakfast, we will visit the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps, and the Pantheon. We will also see the Piazza Navona, St. Ignatius Church, St. Monica Church, and Santa Maria sopra Minerva, where St. Catherine is buried. After lunch (on your own), we will head over to the Trinita Dei Pellegrini for Mass. Pope Benedict made it the parish church for the exclusive celebration of the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite in 2008. The care of the church was given to the FSSP. Dinner will be on your own tonight, and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 8: ROME: BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR / BASILICA OF ST. JOHN THE LATERAN / SCALA SANTA / SANTA **CROCE IN GERUSALEMME**

(Sunday, Nov. 10th) After breakfast, we will begin our day at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, which is dedicated to Our Blessed Mother and contains a relic from the Manger of Jesus. After celebrating Mass, we will visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, which was the primary basilica of the Catholic Church before St. Peter's and where Pope Francis was installed as Bishop of Rome. The relics of Peter and Paul are kept here as well as wood from the table used during the Last Supper. Next, we will visit the Scala Santa (the Holy Steps). These are the steps Jesus walked on during his Passion in Jerusalem, leading up to Pontius Pilate's praetorian. They were brought to Rome by Saint Helena in the 4th century. Afterward, we will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and continue to Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, a minor basilica that holds fragments of the true Cross brought to Rome by St. Helena. Dinner will be on your own tonight and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 9: ROME

(Monday, Nov. 11th) After breakfast, we will journey along the Ancient Appian way to see the Church of Domine Quo Vadis, where tradition says Saint Peter had a vision of the risen Christ while fleeing persecution in Rome. Christ gave him the courage to follow him to martyrdom, as foretold in the Gospels. After celebrating Mass, we will visit the Galleria Borghese to see Bernini & Caravaggio art. After lunch (on your own), you'll have free time this afternoon. Our farewell dinner will be at a local restaurant and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 10 RETURN TO USA

(Tuesday, Nov. 12th) After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our return flight home.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.
