August 18, Monday, Day 1: USA TO IRELAND

Depart on an overnight flight to Ireland. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Add-on flights, optional premium economy, and business class quotes are available upon request starting 120 days before departure.

August 19, Tuesday, Day 2: DUBLIN – GLENDALOUGH – KILKENNY

We arrive in Dublin this morning and are met by our driver-guide. Our pilgrimage starts with a visit to Powerscourt Estate and Gardens, where we have time to explore the magnificent gardens, visit the whiskey-making distillery, and enjoy lunch (not included). Continue to Glendalough, the monastic settlement established by St. Kevin in the 6th century. We visit the spiritual center and celebrate Mass in this holy spot. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kilkenny. (D)

August 20, Wednesday, Day 3: KILKENNY

Our morning begins with a hearty Irish Breakfast, which is included each morning. We explore Kilkenny, a center of government in the Middle Ages, now essential as a hub of Irish arts and handicrafts. We visit Kilkenny Castle, a site steeped in centuries of history. Castle Yard has been converted to house Kilkenny Design Workshops, where we can watch skilled craftsmen working on wood, silver, metal, textiles, and ceramics. Next, we enjoy the Smithwick's Experience Tour; it isn't just for beer lovers. Those who love history and architecture will also gain great insights into Kilkenny's heritage. Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary's Cathedral. (TBC) Overnight in Kilkenny. (B.D)

August 21, Thursday, Day 4: KILKENNY – CASHEL – KILLARNEY

Depart for Cashel to view where St. Patrick is said to have plucked a shamrock to explain the mystery of the Trinity giving a new emblem to Christian Ireland. We continue on to view the magnificent monastic remains of the Rock of Cashel before driving to the wonderful city of Killarney. Mass will be celebrated at St. Finbarrs's Oratory. (TBC) Located on one of the five Pilgrim Paths of Ireland. Dinner is at leisure with overnight at our Killarney hotel. (B)

August 22, Friday, Day 5: RING OF KERRY - SKELLIG EXPERIENCE

We start the day with an enjoyable, panoramic ride to the Ring of Kerry to see the most spectacular scenery in Ireland. We then cruise around Skellig Island (TBC and weather permitting) and visit the museum before returning to Killarney for our dinner and overnight. Mass will be celebrated. (B.D)

August 23, Saturday, Day 6: CLIFFS OF MOHER – GALWAY, THE CITY OF MUSIC AND PUBs

Today we start at the incredible Cliffs of Moher. The magnificent landscape of the Burren awaits us today. Continue through the Burren region to Galway, where we see St. Nicholas Church, celebrate Mass, and enjoy the rest of the day to explore the local pub scene. Galway is the city of music and pubs, and we can visit some of the best in the city. Dinner is at leisure. Overnight in the Galway area (B)

August 24, Sunday, Day 7: ARAN ISLANDS

We have a full-day trip to Inis Mor, the largest of the Aran Islands. We take a ferry from Rossaveal to Kilronan on Inis Mor for island exploration, including a visit to Dun Aonghasa Fort - A stone fort on the western edge of Europe. Many consider this spot one of the most romantic spots in Ireland. Following lunch at Joe Wattys Pub, we have time to hike, pray, and further explore the beautiful landscape before we return to Galway for an overnight. Dinner is at leisure tonight. Mass will be celebrated at the Church of St. Bridget. (TBC). Overnight in the Galway area. (B.L)

August 25, Monday, Day 8: CONNEMARA – CROUGH PATRICK

Our drive along the coast, through the rugged scenery of Connemara, where the inhabitants still speak Gaelic, is, without a doubt, the wildest and most romantic part of Ireland. We stop at Kylemore Abbey, a Benedictine Abbey of great beauty, to celebrate Mass. (TBC). We drive to Croagh Patrick - the 2,500-foot conical-tipped mountain, Holy Mountain, where St. Patrick is said to have spent the forty days of Lent praying and fasting in the year 441 A.D. This Stone Mountain is another famous pilgrimage place where some of the Irish climb barefoot over the rugged rocks to the top. We return to Galway, and dinner is at leisure. Overnight in the Galway area. (B)

August 26, Tuesday, Day 9: SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF KNOCK – WHISKEY DISTILLERY-DUBLIN

This morning, we visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Knock. In 1879, the parish church of Knock was the scene of an apparition of the Blessed Virgin, St. Joseph, and St. John, the Evangelist. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition: Our Lady wore a white cloak with a brilliant crown of roses on her head. In September 1979, St. Pope John Paul II made a pilgrimage to Knock. We celebrate Mass at the Apparition Chapel (TBC), visit the Folk Museum, pray the Stations of the Cross, and pray the Rosary. Our next stop is Kilbeggan Distillery, a traditional Irish whiskey distillery on the River Brosna. Kilbeggan is the oldest distillery in the world, dating back to 1757. We learn the art of making authentic artisan Irish whiskey and have a wee bit of sample for ourselves. After time for a break in Athlone, we continue to Dublin for an overnight. Dinner is at leisure in Dublin. (B)

August 27, Wednesday, Day 10: IRISH DRINK AND DANCE

Our tour includes the famous "Doors of Dublin," the elegant Georgian Squares, and Phoenix Park. We visit Trinity College to see the Book of Kells and Guinness Distillery, where we see how the famous Irish brew is made. We explore the Storehouse, originally built in 1904 to house the Guinness fermentation process. The core of the building is modeled on a giant pint glass. The tour takes us through the brewing process step by step, finishing at the Gravity Bar, where we can taste a pint of Guinness while enjoying panoramic views over Dublin City. The afternoon is a time to explore the city on our own. Mass will be celebrated at the Whitefriar Street Church (TBC). Our farewell dinner is accompanied by music and dancing. Overnight in Dublin. (B. Special dinner)

August 28, Thursday, Day 11: ARRIVAL IN THE USA

This morning, we depart Dublin for our return flight home to the USA. (B)
